township be holden at the house of Joel H. Mendenhall in said
township on the first Monday in April next.

Ordered by the Board that the ^{third and} ~~third~~ quarters of the fifth township
in the sixteenth range be and the same is hereby attached to
and made part of the township of Stingston.

Ordered that the first second and fourth quarters of the sixth
township in the sixteenth range be and the same are hereby at-
tached to and made part of the township of Peru.

Ordered that the fourth quarter of the sixth township in the eighteenth
range be and the same is hereby attached to and made part
of Explored Township.

Board adjourned until tomorrow morning at 9 o'clock.
